OBJECTIVES:

Specific skills :

- deepen knowledge and scientific, technological and operational expertise, in a given topic
- pose a problem
- formalize and organize a reflection
- conduct a relevant and exhaustive research

Communication skills :

- write a scientific report in accordance with ISARA standards and using bibliographic management software
- select and present orally the main aspects of the work carried out, using an appropriate visual support

Interdisciplinary skills

- develop their autonomy and their sense of initiative
- take into account the indications and advices of an expert
- respect instructions and deadlines
- think about your professional orientation

PROGRAMME :

This project consists of experimenting with scientific or technological questioning, based on a recent bibliography, possibly supplemented by interviews, or even laboratory work, and leading at least to a set of motivated questions.

PREREQUISITES:

TEACHING METHODS:

The project takes place over one semester. The subjects are co-constructed by the students and their coordinating teachers. They are generally linked to the optional teaching themes of 4th and 5th year, and to the research or study programs of the Departments.

The follow-up consists of 2 meetings prepared by the student, completed by 2 reports of intermediate activities. This monitoring can be adapted according to the circumstances (project carried out from abroad, or started late)

The student has 125 hours of personal work to complete this project.

EVALUATION METHODS:

The evaluation focuses on the rigor of the process, the synthesis and analysis skills, the relevance of the sources used, the general quality of the process.

These criteria will be assessed on the basis of a written document and an oral report.

The grade awarded takes into account the written document, the oral presentation and the quality of the project management.

Delays may lead to penalties.
